Why a Master's Degree Program for Missions?

We believe the attrition rate in modern missions is too high. The present cost of sending out a missionary is exorbitant. When a missionary doesn't make it on the field, the financial cost and personal cost is high. We believe the time and investment in further training will reduce the attrition rate by fully equipping the missionary and increasing the prospects of success.

Program Requirements

A Bachelor's Degree from an approved college.

Program Outline

A three year program of study in three different locations.

1st Year - In Classroom -- 32 hours of classroom study on the history, theology, philosophy and foundation of Biblical missions and language development studies.

2nd Year - In Culture -- Nine months of on-the-field training with linguistics studies and cultural preparation. This may take place on the mission field alongside an approved missionary or in the United States at an approved training center.

3rd Year - In Service -- A one-year internship in an approved church for the purpose of practical ministry training with the goal of reducing the time necessary for raising financial support for the field.

Scheduled Starting Date -- Fall, 2009
